## PERMITS FOR INFORMAL FOOD TRADERS

- On 25 March 2020, Regulations in terms of Section 27(2) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002) – ("the Act") were issued in Government Notice No. 398 - (hereafter referred to as the "Lockdown Regulations").
- On 2 April 2020, Regulations in terms of Section 27(2) of the Act were issued in Government Notice No. 446 (hereafter referred to as the "Regulations") that, amongst others, amended the Lockdown Regulations.
- 3. Regulation 7(e) of the Regulations require informal traders to obtain written permission from municipalities to operate.

- 4. It has come to our attention that the relevant sections in some municipalities are not open and available to issue such permits to informal traders, and in some instances, there is no standard template to use to provide such written permission.
- 5. To assist informal traders and municipalities in this regard, all municipalities are requested to ensure that the relevant sections dealing with informal trading are opened with immediate effect, and that municipalities utilise the attached template to issue the required written authority to informal food traders, where no such template is available within the municipality.
- 6. In addition, municipalities must ensure that informal food trading (uncooked) takes place in an area specially demarcated for such purpose; that appropriate hygiene and sanitisation services and facilities are provided; and that all COVID-19 and municipal health regulations are strictly adhered to.
- 7. Any permit already issued prior to this Circular remains valid so long as it bears the official stamp of the municipality and the details of the issuer from the municipality.
