**Development and Conduct of an Ambient Air Quality Baseline Study in the Central Karoo District Municipality**

A service provider is sought to develop and conduct an Ambient Air Quality Baseline Study in the Central Karoo District Municipality with the focus on:

1. NO<sup>2</sup> and PM<sub>10</sub> levels - The central city area of Beaufort West, specifically along the N1 (Donkin St.) route, where frequent heavy vehicular activity may present a problem from an emissions perspective and where associated elevated NO<sub>2</sub> and PM levels may prevail within this specific micro climatic zone.
2. Methane gas - With the shale gas development scheduled to take place in the CKDM, it is necessary to establish the current levels before any mining activities take place. This information would form a scientific basis to determine if the shale gas developments impact on the air quality and the environment in Beaufort West.
